

## Croydon Council: Support for Rough Sleepers

If you see anyone who is sleeping outside, preparing to bed down, or sleeping somewhere not designed for habitation, such as a car, ask if they are already known to services.

**If No:** Alert Streetlink via their website <https://thestreetlink.org.uk/> - for all communications from the public to refer people they see sleeping rough.

StreetLink London operates a self-referral phone line for people currently sleeping rough in London to seek support (run by St Mungo's and part-funded by the Mayor). In London, alerts about people sleeping rough will come through to the StreetLink London team who will triage and pass the alerts on to local outreach teams.

How does StreetLink work? To make an alert, follow these 3 simple steps:

1. **Locate:** Pinpoint a specific location of where you have seen the person sleeping rough using our map feature and include a written description of the location.
2. **Describe:** Provide details on the time the person was sleeping rough at the location and any further information about their appearance that can help identify them.
3. **Submit:** Once submitted, your alert goes to the local authority or outreach service in the area. You will receive an update within 10 working days if you have requested it.

Rough sleepers can self-refer directly via [thestreetlink.org.uk](https://thestreetlink.org.uk) or contact the StreetLink London phone line, 0300 500 0914, available 24/7. (This phonenumber is only for people rough sleeping).

\*Important: if you think the person you are concerned about is under 18 call the Police on 999 Do not contact StreetLink.

If someone is homeless, but not sleeping rough, they should submit the self-help application on the [Council website Housing options self-help tool](#):

They will be offered an appointment with the Triage team. On the day they will be asked to provide proof of i.e. 3 month's bank statements, letter to prove the landlord's eviction etc.

## Support for the homeless in the voluntary sector

**CAYSH:** Provides supported accommodation for 16-25-year-olds (must have a Croydon connection; born, lived, or been at school in the borough, family or relatives living there), via referrals from Croydon Council and DIZ team based at Bernard Weatherhill House. Please note - 16 to 17 years olds should be referred to 'SPOC' 020 8726 6100 ext. 84307, before being passed to the Croydon Council DIZ Team for an assessment.

**Crisis Skylight Croydon:** Supports those experiencing homelessness, or are at risk of homelessness. Showers/washing facilities are available to our 'street homeless members'. Whilst our door is open during Skylight opening hours, potential members will be offered a triage appointment, to establish if/how we can support them to end their homelessness, rather than offering facilities without ongoing support. We are open Monday – Friday between 10 am and 4 pm (closed during Bank Holidays). We are not a day centre/accommodation provider.
